

UWF Reading Program 2023

The book list for 2023 is in and I have purchased 20 books. I am also identifying alternative ways to access the books without cost to UWF so that as many books as possible can be available to us. Some of the ways we obtain books are:

- Books purchased by UWF through budget
- Books available for checkout at the Wichita Public Library
- Books purchased by others and donated to the UWF library

If you have any questions about getting a Wichita Public Library card or using the library or obtaining books through Interlibrary Loan, please ask me. There is no charge to interlibrary loan books through Kansas libraries, you just need a current Wichita Public Library card.

After I have purchased and received all the 2023 books, I will be printing a new library catalog listing for our library so that you know how to find the books that are eligible for the 2023 reading program. That printed list will be available on the UWF Library shelf in our West Heights Adult Library and is available on the West Heights UMC web site. I would be glad to email this list to anyone who wants it.

This year I have separated the list: those available at Wichita Public Library and at our UWF Library shelf. Both lists are in our UWF Library Catalog and on the web site.

If any circle would like me to come and speak at their circle meeting, I would be glad to come and share the reading program with you, I would only need about 15 minutes of your time.

There are 5 categories: Bonus Books

1. Education for Mission
2. Leadership Development
3. Social Action
4. Nurturing for Community
5. Spiritual Growth

Plan 1: Read 5 books, 1 from each category

Plan 2: Read 10 books, 2 from each category

Plan 3: Read 15 books, 2 from each category plus 5 more

Plan 4: Read 20 books, 2 from each category plus 10 more

All Plans include reading the Response Magazine .
