• For 2024, books from the 2019, 2020, 2021–2022, 2023, and 2024 Reading Program lists are all eligible for Reading Program reporting credit. There is a list of all these books on our website under the Reading Program.

• You are always welcome to use audiobooks if that's an easier and more accessible way for you to read the material.

- You can also receive Reading Program reporting credit for:
  - Listening to the Faith Talks podcast: 1 credit in Spiritual Growth for 2+ episodes (available on UWF website)
  - Listening to the Voices from the Field podcast: 1 credit in Education for Mission for 2+ episodes (available on UWF website)
  - Reading response magazine: 1 credit in Nurturing for Community for reading one year (6 issues)
  - One copy of the *RESPONSE* magazine is available in our library. The magazine is available online as well, and you can listen to articles through the UWF website.
  - Several movies are also available for Reading Program reporting credit, including Hidden Figures, Pushout, and The Hate U Give. In determining the category for credit, identify the category of the original book and apply credit for the film to the same category
  - Books are available in our church library and at the Wichita Public Library. Lists of these books are available on our website under the Reading Program
